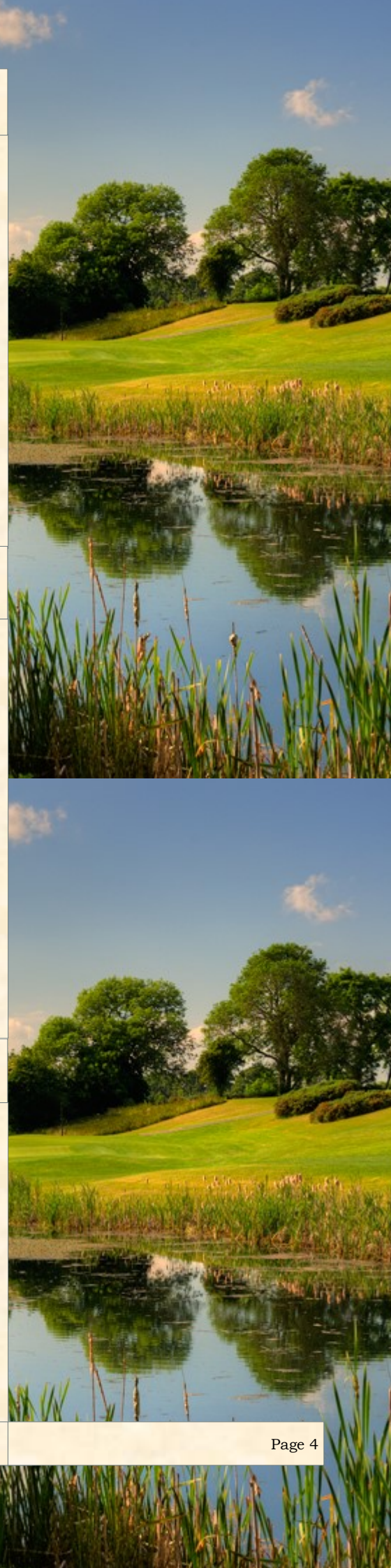
GUI Fun Golf Rules Night March 24th
